


Torbay Health and Wellbeing Board and Natural Devon (Devon Local Nature Partnership)

- 1. Introduction**
 - 1.1 This compact agreement describes the relationship between the Torbay Health and Wellbeing Board and the Devon Local Nature Partnership.
- 2. Shared aim**
 - 2.1 To maximise the health and wellbeing impact of the natural environment in Torbay through shared strategic approaches.
- 3. Shared strategic approaches**
 - 3.1 The natural environment of Torbay and surrounding countryside offers a wide range of opportunities to produce social, economic and environmental, as well as physical and emotional, benefits to health and wellbeing.
 - 3.2 Torbay Health and Wellbeing Board and Devon Local Nature Partnership commit to making explicit strategic objectives which will help achieve the shared aim in both the Torbay 'Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy' and the Devon Local Nature Partnership's prospectus and subsequent implementation plans.
 - 3.3 Through the joint strategic needs assessment process relevant data and the evidence of effectiveness of interventions will be shared and promoted.
 - 3.4 The commissioning plans of the members of the Torbay Health and Wellbeing Board and Devon Local Nature Partnership will set out relevant actions as appropriate.
- 4. Strategic links**
 - 4.1 Devon's Director of Public Health is a Board member of the Devon Local Nature Partnership and represents both the Devon and Torbay Health & Wellbeing Boards.
 - 4.2 The Executive Officer group of the Devon Local Nature Partnership has public health team and Torbay Council representation.
- 5. Annual review**
 - 5.1 This compact agreement will be reviewed annually and commissioning activity reported on.
